WOOD

The wooden items are varnished with a water-based topcoat to repel common substances and fluids, such as coffee, tea and wine. However, the protective coat is no foolproof guarantee against stains. In case of a spill, remove it immediately.

Always use coasters to prevent hot surfaces from leaving marks on the table top.

For regular dusting, use a dry cloth. For a more thorough cleaning, use furniture polish with a soft cloth.



GLASS & MIRROR


Wipe the glass or mirror surface with a neutral glass cleaner and soft cloth.



METAL

Dust regularly using a soft dry cloth. For a more thorough cleaning, use mild soap and warm water. Rinse with clean water and wipe dry.

Do not use steel wool, sandpaper, mineral acid, bleach or chlorine cleaners on metal surfaces.



TABLES WITH METAL BASE

Do not drag tables along the floor, as it might damage the protective coating, cause rusting or leave permanent marks on the floor.

Always lift the furniture when moving them from place to place.

Always ensure water and solutions do not come into contact with the furniture's metal base and the wooden floor, as it might leave permanent marks on the floor. VARNISHED & WAXED TEAK FURNITURE

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THE BEAUTY OF SOLID WOOD

The beauty of natural materials lies in its peculiarities and imperfections. Variations in the wood grain and colour, knots, medullary rays and other natural characteristics are inherent. These are far from flaws, but an intricate part of its character. We believe that these imperfections contribute to the charm of our products.

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CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Ethnicraft's furniture is conceived to adapt well to the hydrometric conditions of its environment, although some cracking or movement may occur. This is a normal adaptation to the furniture's environment

The carved parts of our Tabwa collection are varnished and, to achieve its signature shine, a wax is applied. This finish gives the furniture its desired colour and offers a good protection against stains. Even though with this extensive treatment, spills should be removed immediately.

REGULAR CARE

For regular dusting, use a dry cloth. For cleaning or in case of a spill, use a damp cloth and natural soap. Do not use soap containing detergent or other chemicals. Dry with a soft clean cloth to prevent spotting.

We always recommend protecting surfaces with coasters, mousepads, or placemats as extreme and repetitive daily use or heat can damage the finish. Always move objects such as flowerpots, vases etc from time to time, and ensure any excess water or dampness is wiped dry immediately to prevent marking the surface.

REFRESHING THE SURFACE

Dust the surface first. Apply dark brown liquid beeswax using a soft cloth or a furniture brush. Allow the beeswax to dry. Buff with a clean soft cloth and/or furniture brush. Repeat until the desired level of shine is reached.

- Dust regularly using a soft dry cloth.
- For a more thorough cleaning, use mild soap and warm water.
 Rinse with clean water and wipe dry.
- Do not use steel wool, sandpaper, mineral acid, bleach or chlorine cleaners on metal surfaces.

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UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE LEATHER

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

The upholstery of our leather chairs and sofas should not be washed or dry-cleaned. To keep the leather in optimal condition we recommend the following:

- To avoid discolouration do not place the sofa in direct sunlight.
- Frequently wipe the leather sofa down with a clean, dry cloth.
- Treat spills immediately. Blot up as much of the spill as possible with a clean, dry, white cloth. Don't rub.
- In case of a stain, use a clean, slightly damp white cloth, blotting from the outer edge to the centre of the stain. Do not use any chemical products not designed for leather.
- Use a towel to evenly dry the leather. Do not use a hairdryer for this purpose as it is likely to dehydrate the leather.
- Apply leather conditioner when the leather feels dry.

- Dust regularly using a soft dry cloth.
- For a more thorough cleaning, use mild soap and warm water.
 Rinse with clean water and wipe dry.
- Do not use steel wool, sandpaper, mineral acid, bleach or chlorine cleaners on metal surfaces.

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UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE FABRICS

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CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Upholstered items should not be washed. Taking off the cushion covers and washing these in a machine (even at low temperature) will lighten the colour and shrink the fabric.

If pilling should occur, don't be alarmed. It's a result of excess fibre coming off the fabric or from external sources. This is not a defect but a characteristic of many upholstered fabrics.

To keep upholstery in optimal condition we recommend the following:

- To remove pilling, we recommend using an antipilling machine.
- · Avoid placing the item in direct sunlight.
- For dusting or removing crumbs take a clean cloth or soft brush and wipe down upholstery. Do not rub.
- We do not recommend vacuuming. If you do so, use the lowest suction and a soft upholstery attachment.
- Treat spills immediately. Blot up as much of the spill as possible with a clean, dry, white cloth. Do not rub.
- In case of a stain, use a clean, slightly damp white cloth, blotting from the outer edge to the centre of the stain.
- Do not use any chemical products on your upholstery.
- If in doubt, always refer to the care label specific to your item.

BASE STRUCTURE

We advise the following:

- Dust regularly using a soft dry cloth.
- For a more thorough cleaning, use mild soap and warm water.
 Rinse with clean water and wipe dry.
- Do not use steel wool, sandpaper, mineral acid, bleach or chlorine cleaners on metal surfaces.

WOOD

Our wooden trays and tray tables are varnished with a protective topcoat to repel common substances and fluids, such as coffee, tea and wine. However, the topcoat is no foolproof guarantee against stains. In case of a spill, remove it immediately.

For regular dusting, use a dry cloth. For a more thorough cleaning, use furniture polish with a soft cloth.

Keep coasters handy and use to prevent marking your wooden tray.



GLASS & MIRROR

Wipe the glass or mirror surface with a neutral glass cleaner and a soft cloth.

Use coasters to prevent damaging the tray's surface.



USER INSTRUCTIONS

Our trays are intended for decorative and everyday use. They are not to be used in a setting such as, but not limited to, restaurants where they are exposed to constant washing, repetitive handling and service of heavy items.

Always use coasters to prevent hot surfaces from leaving marks or damaging trays.

TABLE TOP

Your table is varnished with a water-based finish to repel common substances and fluids such as coffee, tea and wine. However, this protective coat is no foolproof guarantee against stains. In case of a spill, remove it immediately.

Always use coasters to prevent the hot surface from leaving marks on the tabletop.

For regular dusting, use a dry cloth. For a more thorough cleaning, use a damp cloth and natural detergents.

METAL LEGS

Dust regularly using a soft dry cloth. For a more thorough cleaning, use mild soap and warm water. Rinse with clean water and wipe dry. Do not use steel wool, sandpaper, mineral acid, bleach or chlorine cleaners on metal surfaces.

USER INSTRUCTIONS

- The table surfaces should be treated carefully as they can get scratched when using aggressive cleaning products and get ruined by extreme heat.
- These products are intended for indoor use only.
- To prevent staining, we recommend that any spills be removed immediately.
- Do not drag the furniture along the floor, always lift the furniture when moving.
- Direct contact with abrasive/high acidity products should be avoided.

OUTDOOR COLLECTION

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CRAFTSMANSHIP

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CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Ethnicraft's outdoor collection is designed to adapt well to a range of environmental conditions, whether that be on an urban terrace or beachfront patio; warm and tropical or cool and mountainous. As the furniture adapts to its environment, it is normal for some cracking and movement to occur.

The beauty of teak is that, even when left in its natural state, outdoors and in any season, it is basically maintenance-free. Our teak range comes without any finish or protective treatment. The wood is merely polished, allowing the natural oils to rise to the surface. The high density of teak wood means it is an excellent choice for outdoor use

Overtime, it is natural for untreated furniture to grey slightly due to prolonged sun and rain exposure. This colour change is purely superficial and does not impact the strength or quality of the timber.

REGULAR CARE

Teak's high density has the advantage that stains do not penetrate the wood as easily. Even with these characteristics, any spills should be removed immediately.

Use place mats and/or coasters to prevent hot pots and pans, or cold glasses and bottles, from leaving marks on the furniture.

For regular wiping, use a dry cloth or soft brush for dusting off crumbs and leaves – do not rub. For cleaning, or in case of a spill, use a damp cloth and natural soap. Wipe in the direction of the grain. Do not use soap containing detergent or other chemicals. Dry with a soft clean cloth to prevent spotting.

With teak's natural oils rising to the surface, it can appear as irregular colouring or appear like a watermark. This is not a flaw, but a natural part of the timber's maturing. Use a damp cloth and natural soap to clean.

After any cleaning, ensure that furniture is dried thoroughly as spores that result in mould growth thrive in prolonged damp and dirty conditions.

Avoid letting water rest on any furniture surfaces for periods of time as permanent water damage can occur on wood, fabric or metal.

All teak items are equipped with glides to prevent water absorption from the ground. As well as preserving the furniture's feet, glides protect ground surfaces from scratches. Important! To prevent warping, before using a sofa with 5 or 6 legs, always adapt the adjustable glides of the middle legs to the ground surface. For stability, middle legs need to be slightly shorter.

Always ensure solutions used to clean paving, patios or terraces do not come into contact with the furniture, as it might leave permanent marks on surfaces. Some wood species contain tannin, which causes the wood to react with metal and leave permanent stains.

Avoid close exposure to heating sources such as outdoor fires, braziers and heaters

THOROUGH CARE

To keep your Ethnicraft outdoor furniture in optimal condition we suggest fitting a custom rain cover during seasons where it is not in use or periods of bad weather.

Ensure the furniture is thoroughly clean and dry before applying the cover protection. For long periods of time we recommend that, if possible, any soft furnishings, cushions etc should be removed and stored indoors.

To remove stubborn stains or superficial scratches to teak surfaces, extra fine sandpaper can be gently used. Always sand in the direction of the wood grain.

RAIN COVERS

Custom-made to fit your Ethnicraft outdoor furniture and upholstery, our rain covers provide excellent protection against water, wind and frost. Guarding against dust, dirt, UV and harsh weather conditions, the covers are breathable to prevent mould and mildew growth. Covers feature metal eyelets for fastening against high winds.

Produced in Europe and handmade using a PU-coated textile specifically developed to protect quality wooden furniture, providing a gentle shield to the surface it rests on. Covers are durable and lightweight to ensure easy fitting.

Before fitting, ensure furniture and upholstery has been cleaned off and is completely dry. Ensure any dirt or leaves have been dusted off surfaces to reduce the chance of mould growth. Any residue or moisture trapped on surfaces can cause mould.

Covers are easy-care, machine washable up to $30\,^{\circ}\text{C/86}\,^{\circ}\text{F}$, and fold down easily for storing. Air dry only, ensure cover is completely dry before storing. For ongoing care, we recommend cleaning any debris off the cover regularly with a cloth, brush or hose.

OUTDOOR UPHOLSTERY & FABRICS

Woven in Belgium, Ethnicraft outdoor fabrics are 100% polypropylene, a synthetic material. Polypropylene by its nature is water-repellent, stain-resistant, as well as resistant to mould, moths and bacteria like no other synthetic or natural fibre. It is also:

- UV resistant.
- Resistant to the action of acids and alkalis.
- Hypoallergenic, with anti-odorant properties.
- Resistant to humidity and, although not completely waterproof, it does not absorb water and is quick-drying.
- Maintenance friendly easily cleaned with clear water and a natural soap. Covers are machine washable up to 40 °C/104 °F.
 Do not use any chemical products not designed for polyester.
- 100% recyclable.

All sit cushions are equipped with an anti-slip fabric on the bottom to ensure cushions remain in the correct position.

The naturally occurring surface oil in teak can cause stains on cushions. To clean, use a damp white cloth, natural soap and clear water. Please note, natural oil transfer from wood to fabric is a recurring process that cannot be prevented.

CUSHION INNERS

All cushions are inserted with a long-lasting, quick-dry foam. This dries quickly after exposure to rain, ocean spray, melting snow, morning dew, or moisture and humidity which can penetrate even a "water repellent" outer shell over a period of time.

METAL STRUCTURE

All metal frames and fixtures have been finished with a protective coating specific to the outdoor environment. For general care and maintenance, we advise the following:

- Dust regularly using a soft dry cloth.
- For a more thorough cleaning, use mild soap and warm water.
- Rinse with clean water and wipe dry.
- Do not use steel wool, sandpaper, mineral acid, bleach or chlorine cleaners on metal surfaces.
- Do not drag the furniture, as it might damage the protective coating, cause rusting or leave permanent marks where it stands. Always lift when moving from place to place.

OILED OAK FURNITURE

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CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Ethnicraft's furniture is conceived to adapt well to the hydrometric conditions of its environment, although some cracking or movement may occur. This is a normal adaptation to the furniture's environment.

Your oak furniture is finished with a pigmented hardwax oil. This finish gives the furniture its desired natural colour and has the advantage that stains do not penetrate the wood as easily. This is no foolproof guarantee against stains. In case of a spill, remove it immediately.

REGULAR CARE

For regular dusting, use a dry cloth. For cleaning or in case of a spill, use a damp cloth and natural soap. Wipe in the direction of the grain. Do not use soap containing detergent or other chemicals. Dry with a soft clean cloth prevent spotting.

We always recommend protecting surfaces with coasters, mousepads, or placemats as extreme and repetitive daily use or heat can damage the finish. Always move objects such as flowerpots, vases etc from time to time, and ensure any excess water or dampness is wiped dry immediately to prevent marking the surface.

REFRESHING THE SURFACE

To refresh your furniture or to remove superficial stains we recommend Osmo Liquid Wax Cleaner (3029). This product cleans & regenerates the elegant character of the wood and slightly reinforces the original protective coating. Osmo Liquid Wax Cleaner is no guarantee against stains.

THOROUGH CARE

The original hardwax coating may need to be renewed. We recommend using Osmo Hardwax Oil Natural (3041). In case of discolouration, stubborn stains or to remove a superficial scratch, we advise to sanding the entire surface first. Make sure the surface is clean and dry before applying the Hardwax Oil. Spread the product evenly over the surface and remove any excess product to avoid spots after drying.

There is a range of cleaning products making claims to be best for mirrors, but the cleaning and maintenance of glass and mirrors are actually simple and inexpensive. We recommend the following:

- The best and safest cleaner for a mirror is clear, warm water on a soft, lint-free cloth. Ensure all water is squeezed from the cloth before wiping. Dry the mirror immediately with a dry lint-free cloth.
- Don't use harsh cleaners for mirror clean up after installation.
 Both acid and alkali substances can damage the front surface, edges, or backing of the mirror. Abrasive cleaners should never be used on any mirror surface.
- Don't spray cleaners directly on the mirror. Instead, apply a small amount of cleaner directly onto a soft, lint-free cloth to wipe the mirror. This will help prevent the cleaner from contacting the edges of the mirror and damaging them.
- Don't use commercial mirror cleaners that contain ammonia or vinegar.
- Do use soft, lint and grit-free cloths to clean a mirror. This
 reduces the chances of scratching.
- Care should always be taken to ensure all joints and edges are dry so that no liquid or cleaner comes into contact with the mirror's edges and backing.

Marble is a natural product, so it needs to be treated with care. Your Ethnicraft marble furniture is finished with an oil protection. This is a transparent layer that does not affect the look of the polished marble.

However, it is important to know that direct contact with abrasive/high acidity products, even natural (lemons, wine, ...), should be avoided. We strongly recommend the use of coasters to prevent cold glasses and bottles from leaving marks on the furniture. Due to the porous nature of marble, remove spills immediately as this could cause permanent stains.

REGULAR CARE

For regular dusting, use a dry cloth. For cleaning or in case of a spill, use a damp cloth and natural soap. Do not use soap containing detergent or other chemicals. Dry with a soft clean cloth to prevent spotting.

METAL STRUCTURE

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Our kilim rugs are made using 100% locally sourced sheep wool. Each yarn is selected to ensure the texture and personality of the final product is maximised. Being wool, your kilim rug is suited for any room of the house and under any furniture item, including chairs, beds, tables, etc. The natural oil content of wool makes your kilim incredibly durable as well as very dirt and moisture resistant.

Kilim weaves result in a flat and durable surface rather than pile types. Your kilim is handwoven on a traditional loom. As the weave is not machine programmed, nuances in the size and colour variations are to be expected.

Due to the handcrafted nature of your kilim there may be the occasional loose end that starts to come undone. If this does occur, do not pull or cut it, instead gently push or tie it back into the weave.

To keep your rug in optimal condition, we recommend the following:

- Vacuuming regularly using longer strokes if possible to avoid too much back and forth motion.
 - o Do be aware of rug edges and corners, these are weaker links and prone to wear faster due to improper use of the vacuum.
- Attend to liquid spills immediately using a clean white cloth to blot up excess moisture.
- Remove any dry or solid matter (food, etc) by scraping excess away with a spoon. Do not rub.

- For stains, we recommend using a clean damp cloth with a little warm water and natural soap to gently work out the stain.
 Ensure the floor below the rug is thoroughly dried after.
- Don't wet the kilim too much, use hot water, steam or any harsh chemicals.
- Take care with solutions designed to clean flooring, as splashes may leave permanent marks.
- Never use salt or vinegar on stains as this can damage the dye.
- If a spill or stain cannot be removed by a damp cloth and natural soap, we recommend dry cleaning by a professional cleaner specialised in rugs.

Our textiles are crafted from the best weaving yarns which are primarily produced in Belgium, France, Italy and Peru. By consciously choosing natural fibres – such as cotton, wool and Belgian linen – we stay true to our values: design pieces full of character, made from quality materials that age beautifully.

If any pilling should occur, don't be alarmed. It's a result of excess fibre coming off the fabric or from external sources. This is not a defect but a characteristic of many textiles.

All of our cushion fillers are 100% duck down and carry the Downpass label, ensuring high quality, ethically sourced materials, from controlled and traceable supply chains. Down cushions carry the advantage of being incredibly long-lasting compared to synthetic alternatives.

Fluff up your cushions regularly, this will allow the down to breathe, ensuring the cushions stay light and feathery.

Every few months, on a sunny, clear day, lay your pillows in the shadow outside. Fluff them up several times and turn after about an hour. The heat will dry out any slight moisture. In addition, the fresh air will give your pillows a wonderful clean smell.

To keep your textiles in optimal condition, we recommend the following:

- To remove any pilling, we recommend using an antipilling machine.
- Avoid prolonged contact with direct sunlight.
- Treat spills immediately. Blot up as much of the spill as possible with a clean, dry, white cloth. Do not rub.
- In case of a stain, use a clean, slightly damp white cloth, blotting from the outer edge to the centre of the stain.
- Use a hairdryer on the lowest heat setting to evenly dry the fabric and prevent moisture rings.
- Do not use any chemical products on your textile.
